Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloud and patchy rain clearing the far southeast in the morning then some
sunshine in all parts. Southern areas should be mostly dry, just a few showers.
The showers more frequent over Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of northwest
England, falling as sleet or snow and giving a covering of snow in places.
Feeling colder in a strong westerly wind.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of northwest England, cloudy and very windy
at times with occasional rain, heavy in the west. Elsewhere it should be mostly
dry and bright and less windy. Mild generally but colder in the far north.
