

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Tuesday 23 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of heavy and thundery showers spread northwards through the day, bringing the risk of torrential downpours, hail and blustery winds. However, away from these showers it will remain dry with sunny spells, and feel very warm and humid. Overnight the heavy showers will become confined to the north and east.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Thundery rain will continue in the northeast of Scotland on Thursday, whilst elsewhere there will be a mixture of sunny spells and isolated showers. A further band of showery rain is then expected to push in from the west on Thursday. Feeling less hot than recently, but still warm.
