

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 02 Aug 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain affecting Scotland and northern England will become heavy at times but should clear during the day. The rest of the UK will be largely dry although scattered showers will develop from late morning, with some these becoming heavy and thundery by afternoon. Becoming largely dry overnight with only isolated showers. Southeastern England remains very warm and humid.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

The weather will remain changeable with sunny spells and scattered, locally thundery showers on Wednesday, followed by longer spells of rain on Thursday. Temperatures will start to fall closer to average though, as winds change to a fresher northwesterly by Thursday evening.
