

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 25 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy start with rain continuing northeastwards, which may be locally heavy.
Brightening up and becoming warm for many from the southwest through the day.
Scattered heavy, thundery showers developing across northern and central areas.
These showers gradually easing and becoming isolated overnight, but showery rain
affecting northeastern Scotland by dawn. Elsewhere, mostly dry and warm, except
a few showers.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Remaining unsettled on both Friday and Saturday with showers developing quite
widely on both days, particularly across northwestern areas, where they may turn
heavy and thundery at times. Also a risk of more organised and heavy
thunderstorms affecting southern England Saturday.
