Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Many places will start cold with some sunshine. Outbreaks of light rain or drizzle will spread into Northern Ireland, Wales and Southwest England by midday and slowly move northeastwards during the day. Eastern parts of Scotland and England will stay dry during daylight hours. Light winds but feeling cold everywhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain still around in eastern parts on Saturday but drier and brighter for a time further west. More rain spreads in quickly to western parts by dusk and all parts overnight. Sunday starts very wet and windy with gales in the west. This clears to blustery showers during the day.
