Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy, windy and very cold in southeast England, but wintry showers should gradually ease. Brighter elsewhere with sunny spells, most lengthy in the west, but also a few wintry showers. Mostly dry overnight with a widespread frost. Light rain, sleet and hill snow will move into northern Scotland with a risk of ice.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday, a frosty, sunny start then generally dry although with more cloud later. Cloudy in the far north with occasional rain, sleet and hill snow. Feeling less cold with lighter winds. Most places dry on Sunday with some sunshine but rain and snow in far north.
