Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Generally cloudy with outbreaks of rain and drizzle, heaviest and most persistent in the northwest, mostly light and patchy in the south and east. Although drier and locally brighter weather should spread eastwards later today, mist, fog and drizzle will persist near southern and western coasts. Feeling warm and humid in brighter, drier spells this afternoon, but temperatures nearer normal in rain. A damp and humid night will follow with further spells of rain and drizzle in many areas.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Continuing changeable with further rain especially in the north, some drier and brighter spells as well especially in the south.
