Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Northern and western parts of the UK should see some rain or showers through the day, elsewhere it will be dry, sunny and very warm, but hot in the Southeast. Rain continues in western England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight, but elsewhere it'll be warm with the chance of showers in Essex and Kent.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain at first across Scotland, northwest England and Wales, this clearing all but western Scotland by midday. A dry day elsewhere with sunny spells, although a few showers may develop in Northern Ireland through the afternoon. Many parts should see some showery rain on Monday.
