

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Brighter and warmer in the south, but the risk of showers. Cloudy and breezy elsewhere, with scattered, heavy showers in the north. Rain across north Wales will gradually clear. Some warm sunshine across western Scotland. Heavy showers persisting for parts of northern England and southern Scotland overnight. Clear spells developing elsewhere, but rain returning to the southwest later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Cloudy with outbreaks of rain in the south on Sunday. Elsewhere, bright spells and heavy showers. Remaining largely cloudy on Monday. Showery rain in the south, and some patchy rain for central Scotland. Otherwise largely dry with some brighter spells.
