

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Tuesday will be dry, cold and sunny for many, however early freezing fog and low cloud in some areas may struggle to clear in the weak winter sunshine, with temperatures consequently suffering. Wintry showers in eastern coastal districts will gradually die out to leave the whole UK dry by dusk.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will start largely dry clear and cold, with further frost and freezing fog. While many areas will again brighten up to sunny spells, cloudier and windier conditions will gradually start to move in from the west later, a process that will continue into Thursday.
