Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy with persistent rain across northern Scotland, heaviest in the northeast.
Elsewhere, sunny spells and showers, with some heavy and thundery downpours.
Southern areas are likely to see the the best of any sunshine. Winds will be
mostly light or moderate and temperatures will be around normal.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

The weather will remain unsettled on both Tuesday and Wednesday. Rain in the far southwest at first on Tuesday will move steadily northeast to be over northern Britain on Wednesday. There will be occasional brighter spells with scattered heavy showers. Temperatures mostly near normal.
