Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Sunny spells developing in England and Wales. Fog slow to clear from central Scotland to northern England. Sunny start in rest of Scotland and Northern Ireland, then cloud increasing, bringing patchy rain to far north by evening. Rain and increasing wind spreading across Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight, frost and fog patches in much of England and Wales.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Scotland, Northern Ireland and the north of England and Wales will be mostly cloudy with outbreaks of rain, also windy with risk of gales in far north. Dry elsewhere with overnight frost and patchy fog. Mild in north, relatively cold in south.
