

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 20 Sep 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland largely cloudy, with occasional light rain and drizzle, except warm and sunny across the far northeast. Northern Ireland dry with sunny spells developing. England and Wales dry and sunny after early mist and fog clears, but staying cloudier across Cumbria. Overnight cloudy conditions persisting across northwest Scotland, otherwise dry with clear skies allowing patchy mist and fog to form.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday cloud and rain will move southeastwards across Northern Ireland and Scotland. Later dry and sunny conditions following to northwest Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere dry and sunny. Monday cloudier across eastern England with light showers, otherwise dry and sunny.
