Northwest windy with rain. Elsewhere largely dry, becoming warm.

Today:

N.Ireland and western Scotland becoming windy with rain, locally heavy and persistent. Elsewhere largely dry and warm with sunny spells.

Tonight:

Mostly dry with late sunshine, then clear spells overnight. Showery rain likely across western England and Wales later.

Outlook for Thursday:

Mostly dry with sunny spells and warm or very warm. Showers across western parts, some heavy and thundery. Isolated showers developing elsewhere.
