Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A mostly dry day with many sunny spells, apart from occasional showers at times in the far southeast and some late rain and hill snow in northwestern areas. Cold with a widespread frost in the morning and again as the evening progresses.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain and hill snow in the north and east, with rain gradually extending to remaining areas during Saturday. By Sunday, rain will mostly clear the south of England early in the morning, with clearer conditions and sunny spells developing throughout, and occasional wintry showers in the north. Rain and hill snow spreading into northern areas during Sunday afternoon.
