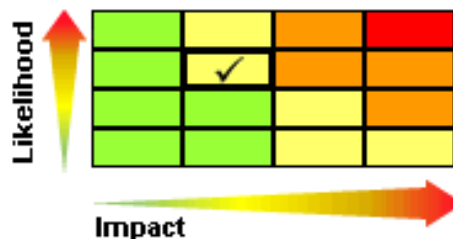
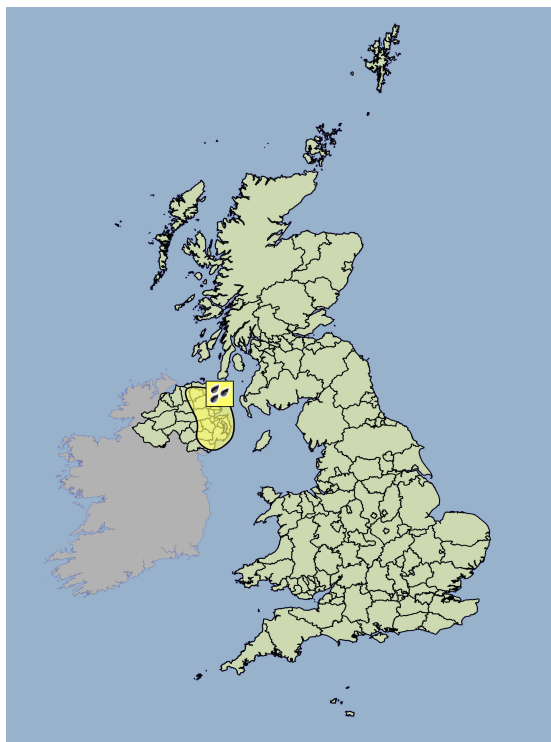




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A depression moving north across over Scotland has introduced an unstable airmass to Northern Ireland. This has resulted in some thundery showers developing this afternoon which are bringing short lived torrential downpours in places along with the risk of localised surface water flooding.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **17:15 on Sun, 03rd Aug 2014** until **20:00 on Sun, 03rd Aug 2014**

Heavy thundery showers have developed this afternoon and are expected to bring some very localised surface water flooding.

The public should be aware of the risk of localised flooding and disruption to transport and outdoor activities.
