

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be initially frosty in northern areas with fog patches and ice on untreated surfaces. Outbreaks of rain will spread northwards, the rain locally quite heavy in Northern Ireland but mostly light and patchy in the east. Most of northern Scotland will be dry. Tonight, mostly frost-free with further rain at times.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday rain in northern and eastern areas will gradually become confined to Scotland. Sunny intervals will follow from the southwest but there will also be some showers, especially in southwestern England. On Saturday most places will be dry and cloudy, but some sunshine will develop locally.
