Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Apart from a little drizzle over the west of Scotland, it will be mostly dry with variable cloud and sunny intervals. The best of the sunshine is likely across northern and some western areas. Temperatures will be near the average for early November. Tonight will remain mostly dry, but rather cloudy, but outbreaks of rain reaching southeast England this evening will spread to other southern and central parts of England and perhaps Wales. A touch of frost is likely in Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Remaining mostly cloudy and generally dry, though outbreaks of rain are expected to spread to many northern and western areas later on Wednesday.
