Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today: Showers heavy and prolonged at times in the cloudier north, but generally more scattered in the south with brighter spells, although again locally heavy and thundery. Southwestern parts turning drier later.  
Tonight: Southern parts becoming dry with clear spells. Continuing showery over Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday: Scotland continuing showery. Rain will spread across southern and western parts during the morning, reaching Northwest England, Midlands and London area later. Eastern most parts staying mainly dry until evening.  
Monday: Rain will clear the south coast during the morning, and then most of Britain and Northern Ireland will be dry with sunny spells developing.
