Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many central and eastern areas will start cloudy with patchy drizzle on coasts. Brighter, warmer weather in the west will spread to most parts later with only eastern coasts remaining cloudy. Some late evening sunshine for many, then overnight cloud in the east will encroach inland again with some patchy drizzle. Northern Ireland will remain clear overnight. Breezy at times.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Low cloud with patchy drizzle on Thursday will clear slowly during the morning to give a brighter, warmer afternoon. A few showers will reach the north later. Warm with sunny spells on Friday, but isolated, thundery showers will develop later.
