Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Morning rain clearing the southeast around lunchtime. Mainly dry with plenty of sunshine elsewhere. More cloud will bring showers to northwest Scotland with a few further south. Windy in the north, temperatures around normal.
Scattered showers to the northwest tonight. Elsewhere dry with clear spells, chilly with local ground frost. Windy in the north, gales in the far north.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Mainly dry with sunny periods, especially in eastern parts, on Friday. Showers over northern Scotland with rain later. Rain over Scotland will gradually feed across much of England during Saturday, becoming increasingly patchy. Dry with sunny spells elsewhere. Temperatures around normal.
