

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Frosty start for northern and western areas, with rain clearing the southeast during the morning. Showers will continue to affect the north and west of Britain, turning heavy, wintry and thundery at times, giving snowfall over the hills. Mainly sunny elsewhere with the odd shower. Showers will continue overnight, easing by dawn. Staying windy throughout with gales in the north.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wintry showers and strong winds will gradually die away on Wednesday, leaving a mostly dry day with plenty of sunshine, although still feeling cold. A bright start on Thursday before cloud and rain spreads southwards turning milder with lighter winds.
