Headline:

Becoming increasingly wet and windy from the southwest, showers following.

This Evening and Tonight:

Cloud and rain spreading east and north, some of it heavy. Clear intervals and scattered heavy showers following into the west, some perhaps thundery. Exposed coasts and hills will become windy, with gales possible in places.

Monday:

Cloudy wet windy weather clearing slowly northeast, sunny periods and heavy, perhaps thundery showers.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Wet in the extreme north, sunshine and heavy showers elsewhere.
