

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain clearing the north and east, leaving a mostly dry day with sunny spells although rain may persist for longer in northeast Scotland. Sharp showers possible in eastern areas until mid afternoon. Chilly overnight but mainly dry with clear spells however some showers may persist over northwestern UK.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday should be generally dry and bright with sunny spells with a few showers. These showers mainly in the north and west, while the southeast should see the best of the dry sunny conditions. Sunday breezy with sunshine and showers in the north, while showery rain should cross southern UK early on.
