Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Patchy rain clears southeastwards then a much brighter but breezy day for most. Scattered showers follow, these mainly in north and west, with snow over northern hills. Feeling more pleasant and less cold in the southeast today. Most places will stay clear overnight and turn cold with a widespread frost developing. Turning wet and windy in the northwest later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Cloud, rain and strong winds continue spreading southeastwards Saturday. Bright and sunny ahead, with the southeast staying dry. Clearer, showery conditions push into the northwest, reaching all parts Sunday. Showers mainly in the north/west and wintry, even some to lower levels.
