Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Most places will be dry with variable, often large amounts of cloud,  
but also some sunny intervals, the best of these mainly for some  
western and southwestern areas. Parts of Northern Ireland, northern  
and western Scotland will be mostly cloudy with a little drizzle, and  
some of this dampness will extend southwards across eastern Scotland  
and into northeast England during the afternoon. It will be  
pleasantly warm in the sunnier west, but northerly winds will keep  
areas near the North Sea feeling chilly.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday will be mostly dry with variable cloud and some sunshine,  
and in some southwestern areas, it should still feel warm. Sunday  
will start dry for most, but eastern England will have some rain at  
times, and further rain will spread to parts of the west later. It  
will be rather chilly, especially in the east.
