Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fairly cloudy in northern and western parts of the UK with a few spots of light rain or drizzle, but cloud should thin and break later. Staying largely dry with bright or sunny spells in eastern areas. Further rain is likely to spread into England and Wales overnight, some heavy, with some scattered showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Occasional rain for England and Wales on Wednesday, then turning brighter later with a few sharp showers. Meanwhile, breezy with sunshine and showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Then, scattered showers for many during Thursday, particularly in northern and eastern parts.
