Headline:

Patchy rain in southeast clearing. Heavier rain affecting Scotland overnight.

Today:

Rain at first in southeastern parts, mostly clearing by the afternoon. A few showery outbreaks elsewhere, mainly near western coasts and over parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland, but many other places dry. Some brighter spells.

Tonight:

Persistent rain moving across Scotland and some other northern areas. Mainly dry in south.

Outlook for Friday:

Band of rain moving erratically southwards. Brighter, colder weather following.
