Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Some early frost patches, then most places in England and Wales will be dry and see some lengthy sunny periods, after mist and fog patches clear later in the morning or by early afternoon. Remaining cloudy across Scotland and Northern Ireland, with drizzle at times mainly over Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It will remain dry throughout with often bright or sunny skies in many places, after drizzle and cloud over northern Britain ease away on Monday. However, areas of mist and fog are likely to form overnight, possibly dense in places, and may linger well into the days, especially in eastern districts.
