Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will continue across parts of Cornwall, with sunny spells and some heavy showers for other parts of southern England and Wales. Elsewhere will be fine and dry though, and warm in the northwest. Today's rain will ease tonight, leaving clear spells. It will be clearer in the northwest, and chilly here, with thicker cloud in the northeast.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be largely dry with sunny spells. A few showers will affect parts of England, mainly in the southeast. It'll be warm for many, but chilly on North Sea coasts. Wednesday will be similar, and warmest in the west.
