Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Outbreaks of heavy rain will continue across northern parts of Scotland, although the Western Isles will be brighter. Rain extending to southeastern Scotland later. England, Wales and Northern Ireland will see scattered, locally heavy possibly thundery showers with brighter spells between. More general heavy rain will move across southern most counties during the day.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday. Outbreaks of rain will spread across northern and western areas with the south and east generally drier and brighter. Turning a little cooler as winds become northwesterly.

Wednesday. Still a few showers across northern and eastern areas, but becoming drier and brighter in the west.
