Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cold day across the UK with further isolated wintry showers in the east of England and Scotland with snow likely across the hills. Staying mainly dry elsewhere, with some sunny spells possible for many. A further band of rain, sleet and hill snow will arrive in the far northwest later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Brisk north-easterly winds for many areas with further wintry showers across some eastern parts on Thursday. Otherwise a dry and cold day with some brighter spells for many. Cold again on Friday, but mainly dry with lighter winds and some bright spells likely. Widespread overnight frosts, locally severe.
