Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Wales and central and southern England will have a cloudy and humid day with outbreaks of locally heavy rain and drizzle, accompanied by extensive hill fog. Further north, after a chilly start, it will be mainly dry with sunny intervals, although patchy rain will edge into Northern Ireland and northern England later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday we can expect either heavy showers or longer spells of rain to affect most areas, although in southeastern England it will be warm, humid and mainly dry. Thursday will be a day of sunny intervals and scattered heavy showers.
