Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Most places will start with a sharp frost along with some patchy freezing fog. Frost and fog should clear slowly, then most places will have a dry, cold day with sunny intervals, though fog may be slow to clear from parts of the south. Northern Scotland will be cloudy, milder and windy with a little rain in the west.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A band of organised rain will gradually edge southeastwards on Monday, but not clearing southeast England until Monday night. Otherwise, strong, cold northwesterly winds will bring a mixture of clear or sunny spells and wintry showers. Frost night and morning inland.
