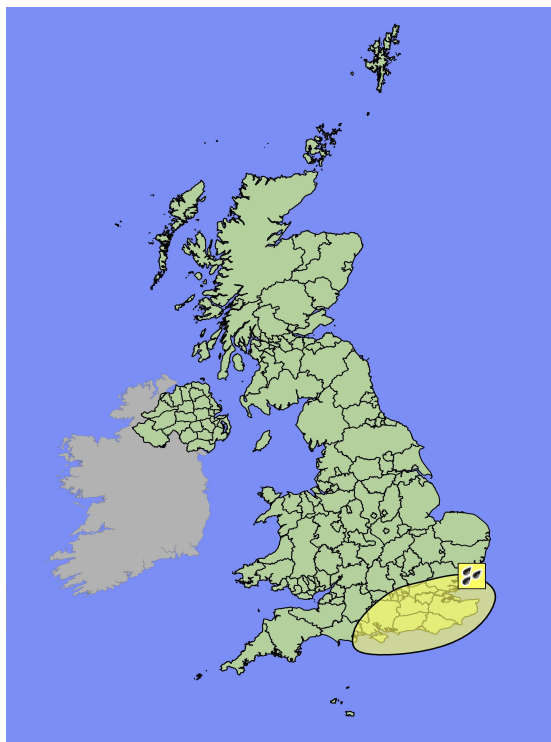




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A shallow depression will become slow-moving over southeast England for much of Monday. As it does so it is likely to bring some heavy rain. Rainfall totals of 20 to 40 mm are likely generally with perhaps as much as 70 mm in a few spots. The more persistent rain may ease from the southeast during the day although this could allow scattered thunderstorms to develop across southeast England. There remains greater than usual uncertainty about the areas most at risk from the heaviest rain and further updates to this warning may well be issued.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Mon, 11th Jun 2012** until **23:55 on Mon, 11th Jun 2012**

Rain is likely to be heavy and persistent at times on Monday across parts of southern England, particularly the southeast where thundery downpours are possible. The public should be aware of the risk of surface water flooding and perhaps some localised river flooding.
