Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Wintry showers will ease slightly across Northern Ireland and Scotland but a band of more persistent rain, sleet and snow will arrive by evening. This will give accumulations of several centimetres for northern Scotland. However, remaining parts of the UK will be mainly dry with bright or sunny spells and just a few showers. It will be windy everywhere though.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will remain unsettled and rather cold across northwest Britain with a little brightness, but also occasional rain and some snow, mainly on hills. Further southeast it will be drier and brighter. It will stay windy however, especially on Thursday.
