

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 08 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales will be dry with increasing amounts of sunshine.
Western districts will see thicker cloud, especially northwest Wales and Cumbria where drizzle is expected. Rain will affect western Scotland, and Northern Ireland for a time. Severe gales possible across northern Scotland. Generally very mild. Some rain affecting western Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight but dry elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain expected across western Scotland on Saturday, this becoming confined to northern Scotland by Sunday. Otherwise it should be dry with plenty of sunshine, especially across southern and eastern England. Fog patches could linger through Sunday, particularly across the Midlands.
