

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Sunday 10 Mar 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
An area of snow is expected to move eastwards across southernmost counties of England during the day, with the potential for significant accumulations in places. This will be accompanied by a strong to gale force northeasterly wind, making it feel particularly cold. Elsewhere, a mixture of sunny spells and snow showers, and less windy in the north.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Any remaining snow should soon clear southeast England on Tuesday, to leave most places somewhat drier, if rather cloudy. Snow showers, already into northeast Scotland on Tuesday will become more numerous along other North Sea coasts into Wednesday. Winds will steadily ease.
