

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 23 Apr 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain will push eastwards across Scotland and central and eastern parts of England today. However, drier, sunnier conditions in the west will follow. Isolated showers may develop, most likely over N.Ireland. Mostly light winds and rather warm. Largely dry into tonight, but showery rain, some heavy, will spread across western parts later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloud and showery rain, some heavy, will move east across most parts on Thursday morning reaching eastern Scotland later. Sunny spells and blustery showers will follow, with some heavy downpours. Largely fine on Friday morning, but rain will become widespread during the afternoon. Temperatures around normal.
