Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Despite some rain in the south-east this morning, much of England, Wales and Northern Ireland will be dry and bright today. However in Scotland there'll be heavy outbreaks of rain and hill snow throughout the day. This evening, heavy showers will push into western parts of the UK, affecting other areas overnight. It'll be cold with some icy patches possible.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
After a cold start on Sunday, it'll be mostly dry with bright spells. The odd shower is possible, and it'll feel chilly. Monday will begin frosty with a few fog patches, but heavy rain and strong winds will arrive later.
