Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Snow showers in southeastern areas will become confined to Kent and Sussex, while snow showers in northern England tend to clear. Otherwise, England and Wales can expect only isolated snow showers. Tonight, widespread frost is likely towards the south, while patchy rain extends elsewhere with some snow, especially on hills.

In Scotland, snow showers in the south and east will clear leaving Scotland and Northern Ireland with patchy rain or sleet moving from the northwest and snow on hills. A change to clearer, showery shower will follow tonight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Some snow in the southeast tomorrow, otherwise staying unsettled and rather cold.
