Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Southern parts mainly dry with sunny spells. Cloud and rain, heavy at times in the far northwest will spread southeastwards across other northern areas, although mostly light in south and east. Feeling rather cold across Scotland as westerly winds strengthen, pleasantly warm in sunshine further south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

On Thursday, Scotland will start cloudy with rain, but become brighter with showers. Other northern areas cloudy with some rain, whilst southern parts stay dry with some sunshine. Friday will see a mixture of sunny intervals and showers, these wintry in the north. Rather cold in north, near normal in south.
