General Situation

High pressure is building from the southwest, bringing settled weather across the United Kingdom over the next few days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight in Moray Firth.

Showers in north.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing south 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rain or showers at first, mainly in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

later in southwest.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or less, then southerly 3 or 4 later.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first, becoming slight later.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.
Fair.
Mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 2 to 4 later.
Moderate, becoming smooth or slight.
Fair.

Southwest backing southeast 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.

General Situation

The ridge of high pressure stretching northeast across Shetland will topple away east with a strong westerly flow following on Wednesday.

Rough, but moderate to east of Shetland and slight in shelter close to east

Wednesday 05 Feb:
West or southwest 5 to 7.
Rough, but slight or moderate in shelter to east of Shetland.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 to 6, veering north 3 to 4 by midnight, then northeast 2 to 3 by
dawn, becoming variable, mainly east, 2 or less by noon tomorrow, becoming east
to southeast 2 to 4 by evening.
Rather rough to rough, becoming slight to moderate with a low swell by tomorrow
morning.
Isolated showers from later tonight until early afternoon.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to southeast 2 to 4, increasing 5 at times by dawn.
Slight, locally smooth, becoming moderate mid-channel later a low swell
throughout.
Fair or fine risk of mist or fog patches near the french coast Thursday
morning.
Good, locally poor or very poor Thursday morning.
