Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Largely cloudy with some wintry flurries in the east and northeast, and occasional rain for central and southeastern areas, heavy at times in the far southeast. Northwest UK mainly dry and bright, especially western Scotland. Feeling chilly. Remaining fairly cloudy overnight, though some clear spells with frost in the west, and mist and fog patches in southern areas.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain and hill snow, heavy at times, will spread from the west on Friday. Snow to lower levels for a time in the north. Rain not reaching the southeast until after dark. Windy on Saturday. Showers in the west. Drier further east.
