Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
It will be a cold start with some fog patches and frost. The fog may persist locally, but otherwise a fine day for many with sunny spells and light winds. Cloud and rain will spread to Scotland and Northern Ireland late afternoon, some of it heavy. Temperatures away from any lingering fog rising to near normal.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Cloud and rain will move southeastwards during Tuesday, sunny spells following into northern and central areas by afternoon. Wednesday will be mostly dry and sunny throughout, once early fog and frost has cleared. Temperatures dropping to a little below normal.
