Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mist and fog patches will slowly clear the south to leave a dry and warm day with sunny spells. However, it may stay murky in places along south-east coasts. Outbreaks of rain will gradually spread across the north and west with strengthening winds. Rain will continue to move south-east overnight and all areas will see some rain by dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will turn very windy across the far north on Tuesday. Bright spells will develop through the day for many and patchy rain will clear the south. Wednesday will be dry for most with variable amounts of cloud and sunny spells.
