for the period 0000 UTC Tuesday 02 November to 0000 UTC Wednesday 03 November 2021

General Situation

A north to northwesterly airflow will gradually become established across the British Isles during the next 24 hours.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 to 6 veering north or northwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, elsewhere mainly slight or moderate, but becoming moderate or rough to the west and north of Orkney.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 to 6.

Rough or very rough to the west and north of Orkney, elsewhere mainly slight or moderate, but becoming rough later near northeastern aberdeenshire.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6 veering west 3 or 4, then north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate, then becoming rough later near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5 veering west 3 or 4, then northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5 veering north 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight becoming moderate, then becoming rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5 veering west 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4 veering northwest 4 or 5, then north 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly veering westerly or northwesterly, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 2 to 4, veering northerly or northwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but mainly northwesterly at first and northerly later, 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, but becoming fair later in west.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 1 to 3, then north 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times, then veering northerly 3 or 4 later, occasionally 5 later in west.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in west.

Showers, becoming fair later in east.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in east, increasing 6 at times in west.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in west.

Showers, but fair at first in east.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 to 4, then becoming northerly 3 or 4 later, occasionally 5 later in west.

Rough at first near land's end, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 until later in east, increasing 6 at times in west.

Moderate or rough in west, slight in east.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 to 4, then mainly north 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time to the east of Anglesey.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, then increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near st david's head.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 to 4, then becoming northerly 4 or 5 later in northwest.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4 at first in south, otherwise northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in south.

Showers, mainly in south.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

West, veering north or northwest later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5 veering west or northwest 3 or 4, then north or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth for a time in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate or rough in far north, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5 veering northwesterly 3 or 4, then northerly 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde and elsewhere in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde and elsewhere in far north, otherwise mainly slight or moderate, but occasionally rough at first near the Mull of Kintyre.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5 veering northwest 3 or 4, then north 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later near western islay and western Tiree.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.

Mainly moderate or rough, but slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then veering north 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough in far north, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.

Rough in far north, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then veering north 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough in south, rough or very rough in north.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Tuesday 02 Nov 2021 at 0000 UTC until Tuesday 02 Nov 2021 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Area of low pressure tracks north towards Norway with an unstable northerly airstream over Shetland Waters on Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of issue.

Northwesterly 4 to 6, but variable 3 at first in the east.
Moderate, but rough in northeast.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Nov until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Nov:
Northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.
Moderate or rough, but very rough in far north later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 in the afternoon, then becoming north later.
Slight or moderate, decreasing smooth or slight after dawn, with a low swell throughout.
Showers, locally heavy, with a risk of hail and thunder.
Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 3 or 4, perhaps locally 5 later.
Smooth or slight with a low swell, perhaps occasionally moderate mid-channel later.
Showers, locally heavy, with a risk of hail and thunder at first.
Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

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
