Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Much of England and Wales will be dry, bright with hazy sunshine developing, although fog may linger in some areas. Northern and western areas will be cloudier with patchy drizzle in the west. Rain will spread across Northern Ireland and Scotland, becoming heavier towards evening. Overnight the rain reaches northern England and north Wales, clearer weather following into the north. Mostly mild.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Cloudy and damp across the south on Sunday, mostly sunny in the north and east before rain spread to the northwest later. On Monday, the rain in the northwest spreads southeast into northern England. Temperatures mostly near average.
