

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Scotland will be cloudy and increasingly windy today, with some rain. Elsewhere will start frosty with some fog, but otherwise will be dry and largely sunny, but rather cold. Rain will push southeast across Scotland and N.Ireland this evening, down to northern England and north Wales overnight. Dry elsewhere with some frost and fog or low cloud developing.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain will move south across England and Wales during Monday, although southern areas should start dry and bright. Colder weather with sunny spells and showers, wintry on hills, will follow. Showers will be mainly around coasts on Tuesday. Mostly rather cold.
