

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain in the south will only slowly clear today, perhaps lingering in the southeast until evening. Most other areas will see sunny intervals and scattered, locally heavy showers. Tonight most central and southern areas will be dry with clear spells, although there may be showers in the east and far west, and outbreaks of rain will affect northwest Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will be largely dry with sunny spells, although a few showers will develop and these could become persistent over Scotland. Monday will be breezy with rain spreading to many areas, this becoming persistent and locally heavy in the west.
